

PSAT Information for 9th, 10th, and 11th Grade Students

Students in grades 9, 10, and 11 will take a Preliminary SAT (PSAT) on October 10, 2018. Ninth grade students will take the PSAT 8/9, which is specifically designed for eighth and ninth graders. Tenth and eleventh grade students will take the PSAT/National Merit Scholarship Qualifying Test (PSAT/NMSQT). The PSAT tests are designed to promote college readiness while preparing students for college entrance assessments.



FCPS will provide the PSAT 8/9 to ninth graders and the PSAT/NMSQT to tenth graders without cost. The cost of the test for eleventh grade students is \$20.00, and students will register for the PSAT at their schools.

All students in 9th and 10th grade who complete the test will receive an individual customized score report from College Board, which will provide feedback based on their responses to the test questions. This will be helpful to tenth graders in preparing to take the PSAT again in eleventh grade and for students preparing to take the SAT.

All 11th grade students who wish to receive an individual customized score report and be in consideration for National Merit Scholarships MUST complete the registration form below and pay the \$20 registration fee (using MySchoolBucks, cash or check). Registration forms and payment can be submitted on Locker Day (August 23rd) or mailed to Robinson to the attention of the Student Services office (5035 Sideburn Road, Fairfax, VA 22032).
