FAQ

How much does JUST a photo for the yearbook cost?	This is FREE . You will receive instructions from Lifetouch on how to choose your yearbook pose. No purchase required. Remember, if you don't have your photo taken, it will NOT appear in the yearbook. Photos must be taken no later than November 6.
Do I have to use Lifetouch for my YEARBOOK photo?	YES
What is the number parents/students should use to reschedule a senior portrait?	1-800-445-1189
Can students walk in to have their portrait taken on any of the days listed above?	NO, absolutely not.
How long does it take to have senior proofs sent to parents?	Please allow up to 2 weeks after the date they were photographed. Please make sure they have the correct address.
Which number should parents call with questions about proofs and ordering?	1-800-445-1189 (Lifetouch customer service line) or call the senior hotline at . . . 800-736-4775
If seniors miss ALL of these dates, are there any other options?	They can call 1-800-445-1189 to schedule a studio appointment. However, if the photo is taken after NOVEMBER 6, the image will NOT be accepted for yearbook use due to publishing

	deadlines.
What do seniors wear to their portrait sitting?	Typically students wear a drape or tux provided by Lifetouch to create a formal photo. This year, that is not possible due to COVID-19. Students are expected to dress appropriately for their photos and should follow dress code guidelines of the Students Rights and Responsibilities.
Yes, I understand the new guidelines, but what should seniors wear?	Here are some ideas if you'd like to recreate the traditional formal photo: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Suit and tie ● Shirt and tie ● Solid colored polo shirt ● Nice dress or top (no strapless or spaghetti straps due to photo cropping at studio) ● Please do NOT wear t-shirts as this is a formal picture.

Dear parents of seniors,

Out of an abundance of caution, FCPS is directing that Senior Portraits be taken in clothing that the student wears to the photo session and NOT shared garments supplied by the photographer (drapes, tuxedo jackets, etc.). Lifetouch is aware of this requirement and will be practicing all health and safety protocols when scheduling the photo appointments.

Students are expected to dress appropriately for their photos and should follow dress code guidelines of the Students Rights and Responsibilities which states that clothing should fit, be neat and clean, and conform to standards of good taste, and decency. Clothing that exposes private areas or an excessive amount of bare skin is prohibited. Examples of prohibited clothing include, but are not limited to: sagging or low-cut pants, tube or halter tops, clothing with inappropriate language or that represents any form of illegal substances, clothing constructed of see through materials, and head coverings unless required for religious or medical purposes.

We appreciate everyone's efforts as the health and safety of our students and staff remains our utmost priority.

These protocols follow the guidelines and recommendations of the Center for Disease Control (CDC), U.S. Department of Health & Human Services (HHS), and Occupational Safety and Health Administration (OSHA) standards related to COVID-19.

Our new photography safety protocols include



ENHANCED CLEANING

Photographers are provided sanitizing wipes and spray to clean camera stations and equipment



NO-CONTACT POSING & SOCIAL DISTANCING

Photographers are required to maintain six feet between themselves and subjects while being photographed



PRE-SESSION HEALTH CHECK

Photographers are provided a thermometer for their daily self-health assessment before reporting to a photography event



SAFETY TRAINING

Lifetouch employees are required to complete comprehensive safety and cleaning protocol training



MASKS

Photographers are required to wear masks during the entire photography session



CUSTOMIZED PLAN
