

- Transcript
 - How well you have done in the classes you have taken?
 - Did you challenge yourself appropriately?
- SAT/ACT
 - Test Optional- may not be required for each school
- Essay
- Activities/Experiences/Leadership
- Recommendation letters
- Visits to campus/communication



WHAT SHOULD STUDENTS BE DOING NOW?

- 1. Review the College Application Checklist
- 2. Narrow down your list to 6-8 schools
 - -Sign up for College Rep Visits in Naviance at Robinson
 - -VISIT CAMPUS/schedule a tour!
- 3. Use Naviance to create lists using tools like SuperMatch & Scattergrams
- 4. Visit each school's website to review specific requirements
 - Utilize the College Application Tracker
- 5. Complete and submit documents in Student Services Schoology
 - -Consent to release student records
 - -Student Input form
 - -<u>Transcript request</u> (Unofficial may be found in StudentVue/ParentVue)
- 6. Complete FAFSA beginning December 2023
 - -Attend fall Financial Aid Night: Virtual 10/28, 11/14

 - Deferred
- Self-Report Schools
 - Unofficial transcript available in StudentVUE

- official SAT/ACT scores to the colleges through the testing service site
- Transcripts & application docs are sent electronically by counselors

REQUESTING A TRANSCRIPT

- Complete the "FERPA Waiver" (Consent to release student records)
 once & upload to Student Services Schoology
- If counselor letter of recommendation is required by your college(s), complete and upload Student/Parent Input Form in Student Services Schoology.
- 3. Complete Transcript Request Google Form for each college/scholarship. Unofficial transcript available in StudentVUE
- 4. Add School Counselor email as Recommender to Common Application with ofcps.edu email address.

LETTER OF RECOMMENDATION

- First, check with college's admission website of each school, to see if a letter is REQUIRED from school counselor
- If required, student will submit completed forms in Schoology by transcript deadline
 - 1. Student/parent input form
 - 2. Consent for Release of Student Records form
- School Counselor must be added as recommender with their @fcps.edu email to Common App. Without this step, the app is incomplete
- Teacher letter of recommendation:
 - Provide at least 1 month notice to teacher
 - Provide list of accomplishments in their class
 - Add the teachers name and email in application

- Recruited for Division I or Division II sports in college?
- Get all necessary forms from NCAA website: http://www.ncaa.org/student-athletes
- Complete Transcript Request Form
- SAT score code 9999





FINANCIAL AID INFORMATION

- Free Application for Federal Student Aid
 - Available December 2023
 - Based on 2022 tax return, must be completed each year
 - What <u>documents</u> do you need?
- Scholarships- NAVIANCE
 - Private
 - School Specific Merit
 - Nominated
- TAG Grants (Virginia Private Colleges)
- CSS Profile (by College Board)
 - Certain colleges use this to award financial aid (UVA, W&M)
 - Can begin filling out in the Fall
- Loans- \$\$ you will owe, plus interest!




