IB French SL 1 (not French 1)

Chers élèves de la future classe de Français Bac 1,

I'm so pleased that you have chosen to continue your study of French at Robinson—bravo!

In order to transition as successfully as possible from French 3 to IB French 1, you will need to do a few things over the summer.

- All students in the course must purchase the following workbook as soon as possible: *Practice Makes Perfect: Complete French All-in-One* by Annie Heminway, Editor (Language Lab McGraw-Hill Education, ISBN # 978-0-07-181954-1) \$25 or so from Amazon.com (normal price is \$36). Do not purchase the e-book! This workbook which has a key will be used as well in IB French 2 the following year.
- If you've been told to do some review over the break (or if you wish to keep sharp), do the following work in the workbook: Read **Chapter 33** "*French in conversation: Meeting people*" pages 478 to 490; all four dialogues. Complete the corresponding short exercises; there are 11 of them. Mark up the dialogue/explanations, for important vocabulary/grammar to stand out. Correct your work (in red or a color that stands out) with the key at the back of the workbook. Consider redoing any exercise that caused you some problems, or doing others throughout the end of workbook. Bring in the workbook with the completed exercises on the first day of school in order to receive 20 points (as an enrichment activity)
- During the summer, all students in the course must review from time to time verb conjugation of the present, the *passé composé*, the *imparfait*, the *futur simple* of the **Indicative**, the present of the **Subjunctive**, the present of the **Conditional**, the present of the **Imperative** and the *futur proche* of the following 30 verbs: **parler, choisir, attendre, avoir, être, aller, faire, pouvoir, vouloir, devoir, connaître, courir, croire, dire, écrire, falloir, lire, mettre, ouvrir, paraître, partir, prendre, recevoir, savoir, se sentir, sortir, suivre, venir, vivre, voir**.
I ask you to consider reviewing them with <https://www.scholingua.com/fr/fr/entraîneur-de-conjugaison>.
There will be a test of these verbs (in the tenses and modes mentioned above) in the first quarter.
- Do any of this work, progressively over the summer; once a week, for 30 minutes or so, should be the goal—NOT the last week of summer vacation.
